God called her into ordained ministry as a teenager. Rev. Matos studied clinical psychology at the *Universidad Automona de Santo Domingo* from 2000 to 2002. She immigrated to the United States at the end of 2002. In 2010, Rev. Matos earned a bachelor of liberal arts degree in psychology from Harvard University and a master of divinity degree from Boston University School of Theology (BUSTH) in 2013. While pursuing her master's degree, Rev. Matos co-founded BUSTH's Raíces Latinas Students Association and served as its first president. She also served as a pastor while in seminary and achieved ordination in 2016. Rev. Matos has ministered at the conference, national, and international levels. She is a gifted preacher and a creative designer of worship services who has served five churches in the New England Conference. Rev. Matos joined West Chelmsford UMC in July 2021 with her two precious girls, Anisha (5) and Geila (7).
